North Central School District Guidelines Wednesday Night and Sunday Activities

Wednesday night activities

Wednesday night is considered family night for the North Central Schools. All school related activities are to be completed by 6:30 p.m. on Wednesday.

The only exceptions to the guidelines are:

1. State sponsored activities scheduled for a Wednesday night. Example is State sponsored tournaments.
2. A calamity that would cause the schedule to be altered. Must be approved by the Superintendent.
3. Activity that cannot be scheduled at any other time. The activity must be presented to the Superintendent or his designate so the Ministerial Association can be contacted, then subsequently approved by the Superintendent.

Sunday activities

The North Central Board of Education wishes to keep Sunday's exempt from school activities to insure ample family time. There are times that school activities can be scheduled but must meet the following criteria:

1. Activities need to be scheduled between 12 noon and 6:30 p.m. and will be considered voluntary attendance.
2. Any activity must be approved by the Principal and the Superintendent with an explanation of the need for the Sunday activity

Sunday activities are not recommended and every effort must be examined before a Sunday activity is proposed.
